## Art. Books. Art Books. Book Art: An Embarrassment of Riches

Another happy foray down the art/book rabbit hole is an exhibition I attended last week, "Fages," on view through Jan. 13, 2013, at the Alyce de Roulet Williamson Gallery at Art Center College of Design here in Pasadena. "Pages" displays the work of contemporary artists who use books and pages as mediums, alongside manuscripts, documents, doodles and other forms of written or printed pages from the 15th Century to the 21st.



New York artist Robert Kushner's "Scriptorium: Devout Exercises of the Heart" consists of hundreds of drawings and paintings of foliage and flowers on antique book pages and covers, and is hung salon style with pins on a wall that spans the entire depth of the gallery space. Opposite the wall is a row of six vitrines displaying pages from 15th and 16th Century Herbols, the neat calligraphy and herbal illustrations quietly foreshadowing Kushner's impressive installation.
